Inspired by that presentation, Mathew felt motivated to join a place where he could begin to rebuild his confidence and sense of purpose.

Since becoming a member, Mathew has become a vital part of the Clubhouse, especially in the Culinary Unit, where he helps prep, cook, and serve meals daily to fellow members. “It’s helped give me the will to work again,” he shared. His contributions not only support his own growth but also help strengthen and nourish the entire Clubhouse community. After more than a decade away from the workforce, Mathew has started submitting job applications, a milestone that reflects the skills, confidence, and hope he has gained through his time at Hope Clubhouse. His story highlights the power of community, structure, and compassion in fostering healing, connection, and new beginnings.
